QUICK REFERENCE SHEET

Colleges: This tab allows users to search through various colleges and create a list of those they are interested in. It allows users to compare themselves to other students who recently applied to those schools as well as allowing them to request transcripts and letters of recommendation. It also provides students with scholarship opportunities and provides direct links for them to apply.

Careers: This tab allows users to explore careers of interest. Users can select careers and receive detailed information regarding the knowledge and skills required, the typical tasks and daily activities, as well as average salary and wages.

About me: This tab stores the user's personal info such as test scores. It is also the home to various personal discovery assessments such as the "StrengthsExplorer," a tool used to uncover talents and reveal personal strengths.

My planner: This tab allows users to create a list of goals, create to-do lists, and check assigned tasks.
