HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

- Homework will be based on class level. You can expect the amount of time spent and effort put forth to increase as the course level increases.
 - On Grade Level \rightarrow Honors \rightarrow GT \rightarrow AP
 - The higher the level the greater the expectation
- Differences between 8th grade and 9th grade workloads and expectations

SPECIFIC QUESTION ANSWERS

1. Do students use lockers? a. All students are allowed to get a locker, but many students choose not to. Lockers are offered during the first week of school by your 3rd period teacher 2. Are there signs in the hallway to help me find room locations? a. Yes! There are signs throughout the building to help you find your way. Teachers also stand in the hallways during the first few days of school to help you find your way. 3. Is there a limit on how many clubs you can join? a. No, you can join as many as you want/as many as fit in your schedule 4. When do clubs meet?

a. After school or during Viking Time

SPECIFIC QUESTION ANSWERS

1. When/Where do I get my schedule for next year? a. Students access their schedule through synergy and will receive an email closer to the start of the school year that tells them when they can access it. 2. School Timing? a. 7:25 AM - start of first period b. 2:10 PM - end of last period 3. Will classes have mixed grades? a. Yes, many classes are not grade specific, and will therefore have students from multiple grades in them. 4. Will I get to walk my schedule before the first day of school? a. Typically yes. Students go to each of their classes and meet their teachers during 9th grade/New student orientation in the fall
