

Mount Hebron High School Online Course Registration

- ➤ You are receiving a preprinted **colored** student registration form and a corresponding **colored** course options sheet. Your registration form has recommendations from your teachers for the core courses required for graduation.
- ➤ If you or your parent/guardian **disagree** with a teacher-recommended course, you will need to complete and sign the Course Placement Review form on the back of the printed registration form and **return it to your school counselor no later than January 18th.**No forms will be accepted after this date.
- A student who is presently failing an assessed course will be recommended for the same course for the next year. If you pass the course by the end of this year, an adjustment will be made by your counselor.
- ➤ You will need to consult both the online course catalog, http://www.hcpss.org/f/academics/hs-catalog-2019-20.pdf and the course options sheet for the appropriate courses to select.
- You are to log in to your HCPSS Connect account, www.hcpss.me, and sign up for a total of 7 classes and 3 alternate classes. Use great care in selecting both your elective and alternate courses. You will not be permitted to change electives after the start of next school year, so any changes to electives <u>must be made</u> prior to this date.
- According to BOE guidelines, you may request any elective course listed in the online course catalog. *There is no guarantee the course will run or have a seat available*.
- ➤ Choose electives and alternate courses that you are interested in. These selections will be reviewed when meeting with school counselors, between January 29 and February 14, during your Social Studies class. If you do not have a Social Studies class, your counselor will set an individual meeting with you.
- ➤ Online registration closes January 18, 2018. You cannot make any online changes after this date.
- If you lose your registration form, you can see your recommended courses by logging into your hcpss.me (Synergy) account. Go to Student Services for a new Course Placement Review form, a Course Options sheet or directions.
